1 大庄屋三木家住宅 県指定重要有形文化財

姫路藩の大庄屋として地域の中心的存在だった三木家や地域の歴史を紹介。柳田國男が11歳の頃に1年間過ごす。

2 旧辻川郵便局 国登録有形文化財

大正12年に三木家9代当主の拙二により建てられ、2階部分は電信電話局の役割もしていた（現在は、客室として利用）。

3 有井堂

旅をしていた神積寺の開祖慶芳上人がこのお堂に泊まり、夢のお告げにより、神積寺を建立したとされている。

4 柳田國男生家 県指定重要民俗文化財

柳田國男が幼少期を過ごした家。著書「故郷七十年」では、自ら「日本一小さい家だ」とい、民俗学を志すきっかけとなったと記している。

5 柳田國男・松岡家記念館

柳田國男が愛用した机や、それぞれの分野で活躍した國男の兄弟等の貴重な資料を豊富に展示。

6 神崎郡歴史民俗資料館 県指定重要有形文化財

明治19年に建てられた郡役所。貴重な歴史・民俗資料などを展示。

7 鈴ノ森神社

松岡家の氏神で、学問や安産の神様が祀られている。境内には町指定天然記念物のヤマモモの木がある。

8 高藤稲荷

柳田國男がよく遊んだ所で、稲荷信仰や狐研究を始めた基になっている。

9 福崎町辻川観光交流センター

福崎町のお土産や妖怪グッズが購入できる他、散策途中のカフェ休憩にも最適。11時～14時の間は、特産品の「もち麦」を使ったカレーも食べられる。

10 熊野神社

毎年10月に開催される秋祭りで、豪華な神輿屋台とふとん屋台12台が境内を練る様は圧巻。浄舞は町指定重要民俗文化財。

11 地藏堂

子どもを健康にし、頭の良い子にする御利益があるとされている。柳田國男の祖母小鶴が日詣りをし、國男兄弟も連れられて詣っている。

12 駒ヶ岩

このあたりで泳いでいると河童のガタロウ（河太郎）にいたずらされたという話があるといわれている。

13 神積寺

国指定重要文化財の木造業師如来坐像を本尊とする。成人式には鬼遣い、春分の日には文殊会式等の年中行事がある。

1 Miki family residence
 Prefecture as an important tangible cultural property




The head of the Miki family served as the headman of the Himeji domain, and the Miki family played a central role in the local community. Described here is the history of the Miki family and of the region. Kunio Yanagita spent a year here when he was 11 years old.

2 Former Tsujikawa Post Office
 Nationally designated as a Tangible Cultural Property




Tsujikawa Post Office was built in 1922 by Setsuji, the 9th head of the Miki family, and the second floor also served as a telegraph and telephone exchange. (currently used as guest rooms).

3 Ariidou




Keiho Shonin, the founder of Jinshaku Temple, is said to have stayed in this religious hut while traveling, and he built the temple as a result of portents in a dream. One of Kunio Yanagita's memorable places from his childhood.
 2 minutes walk from S

4 Yanagita Kunio's birthplace
 Prefecture as an important tangible cultural property



This is the house where Kunio Yanagita spent his childhood. In his book, "70 Years in My Hometown," he said that it was the smallest house in Japan and that it inspired him to pursue folklore studies.

5 The Yanagita Kunio and Matsuoka Family Memorial Museum




In addition to a desk used by Kunio Yanagita and a trove of other valuable materials from his brothers, who were active in different fields, are on exhibit.

6 Kanzaki County Museum of History and Folklore
 Prefecture as an important tangible cultural property



The county office was built in 1886. Exhibits include valuable historical and folklore materials. A fine example of meiji architecture in the area.

7 Suzunomori Shrine




This shrine is dedicated to the deity of the Matsuoka family, the deity of learning and easy deliveries. There is a red bayberry tree on the shrine premises that has been designated as a natural treasure by the town.

8 Takafuji Inari



Kunio Yanagita often played here, and this is the basis for his belief in Inari [the deity of agriculture and commerce who uses foxes as messengers] and his study of beliefs about foxes.

9 Tsujikawa Tourist Exchange Center in the Town of Fukusaki



The Center has goods decorated with supernatural beings and souvenirs from the Town of Fukusaki, and the café is a great place to take a break during your walk. From 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM, you can also enjoy a curry using "Mochi Mugi" (sticky barley), a specialty of the town.

10 Kumano Shrine




A fall festival is held in October every year, and the parade of splendid portable shrines and 12 futon stalls on the shrine premises is a sight to behold. The Jo [purification] dance has been designated as an important folk cultural property by the town.

11 Jizodou




This religious hut is said to bring blessings by making children healthy and smart. Kunio Yanagita's grandmother Kotsuru visited the religious hut, and she also brought his brothers with her to the religious hut.

12 Komagaiwa



The kappa [water imp] Gataro is said to have played tricks on people who swam in this area.
 12 minutes walk from S

13 Jinshaku Temple



The idol of this temple is a wooden seated statue of Bhaiṣajyaguru [the Medicine Buddha], which has been nationally designated as an important cultural property. At this temple, festivals such as 'Oni-Oi' (Demon Expelling Ceremony) during the Coming of Age Day and 'Monju-e-Shiki' (Monju Festival) on the Spring Equinox Day are held.
